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WHERE AM I?

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40 months traveling, more than 45000 km (28,125 miles) ridden, hundreds of days on the roads... the numbers keep growing and never stop looking like science fiction to me! That's how I arrived to Neuquén, after traversing the lonely roads of La Pampa, with endless deserts, barren by the strong winds that have only been the prelude of what's waiting for me in Patagonia. The rain arrived in an unusual way, and in places that haven't seen any water in more than a year, the skies opened up and forced me to retreat to the campground bathrooms at the Lihuel Calel National Park.

Again, it was on the road, that I made new friends, like Raul Reynoso and Angela, from General Roca, and I met again with great life friends, like Walter Morris and his family and Andrea Ledesma. They transformed Neuquén into my new home in my long trip towards the end of the Americas, and I will stay here a few days before continuing my route to the Andes mountains.
